## Updated metering system coming this fall

Access Energy Cooperative is dedicated to exceeding our members' expectations for safe, reliable, efficient service while being a good citizen in our communities. We are always looking forward, making sure the cooperative is well-positioned to meet your needs today and in the future.

Technology is continually evolving and creating new opportunities to provide you with improved services. In 2002, Access Energy Cooperative installed an automated meter reading system that provided our members with the best available method to receive electricity data in more frequent incremental time periods. Since that time, electrical metering technology has continued to advance just like nearly all forms of technology used today. For example, iPhones didn't even exist when we installed our first automated meters!

While this early version of the system has been a valuable tool for us, it has exhausted its useful life. It is difficult to acquire replacement parts, and we are spending resources to maintain an outdated system. Just as TVs, computers and cell phones have been enhanced in the past two decades, so has automated metering technology.

In recent months, we have spent considerable time evaluating upgraded technology and are pleased that a modern and robust solution is available to meet the expectations of our members. The most important priorities are that it provides safe, reliable and efficient service.

Upgrading our metering system

provides cooperative members and staff with key information that is beneficial in designing,



operating and maintaining our electric system. For example, we'll have access to timely outage data, which helps us to restore power more efficiently to you when there's an outage. Through SmartHub, members will be able to see their near real-time energy use, giving you the power to

make decisions on how you are using electricity.

We believe our members will appreciate the exceptional benefits of the new metering system. However,

we have developed a fee-

with us. We have been using automated meters for nearly two decades, so we do not manually read meters. If the meter does not communicate remotely, we will have to read it manually. It will cost the co-op extra staff time and fuel to do so. Paperwork for opt-out decisions is available at the cooperative office and must be completed and received at our office by August 15.

Next month in *Living with Energy in Iowa*, we will discuss the benefits in more detail and dispel some common myths related to radio frequency emissions and privacy. Most importantly, Access Energy Cooperative would never invest in a technology that presents a health or safety risk to our members or employees. Like you, many of us are also members of the cooperative and care about the same things you do.

### **Meet Sheryl Dorn**

Sheryl Dorn is the Director of Administrative Services at Access Energy Cooperative. She has been serving our members in the role for 21 years.



The calendars will be available for you to pick up at the Annual Meeting – or you can stop by our office after August 6. 🗲









