Please be advised that in order to qualify for the trip, students must be a sophomore or junior in high school and are required to participate in a personal interview at our office on March 6, 2024.

Two students will be chosen to participate in the Rural Electric Youth Tour on June 15-21, 2024, affording them opportunities to learn first-hand what it is like to be involved in politics, community development and today's social issues.

While in Washington, more than 1,400 students from across the country will visit historic sites and museums, meet with their Senators and House Representatives where they discuss the process of government and discuss current issues, and increase their knowledge of cooperative electric utilities and American history.
