Water Heater Rebate Application Information

LOAD CONTROL TERMS

- This water heater must be hooked up electrically according to the National Electric Code and be used for the purpose of water heating.
- The cooperative reserves the right to conduct subsequent inspections of the water heater, associated wiring, and metering during regular working hours.
- Access Energy Cooperative and/or its power supplier, at their expense has the right to manage (control) the member's electric water heater load at such times and periods as determined by the cooperative and/or its power supplier. The load will not be controlled for more than six (6) consecutive hours in any twenty-four (24) hour calendar day. The control equipment may be installed at any time after the execution of this agreement.
- This agreement will remain in effect for the lifetime of the water heater. Cancellation of the agreement may result in a reimbursement of the rebate.
- Access Energy Cooperative and/or its power supplier shall not be liable to the member for any damage or loss which may be alleged to
 result from any malfunction of the control equipment installed under this Agreement, or from any electric power interruption, including
 interruptions caused by the control by Access Energy Cooperative or its power supplier.
- This Load Control Agreement shall be binding upon the parties and their respective successors and assigns executed the day and year first above written.

ADDITIONAL TERMS

- Applicant must be a member of Access Energy Cooperative.
- Rebates are limited to eligible services (homes, lake homes, shops, barns, etc) that use more than 6,000 kilowatt-hours of electricity on an annual basis.
- The water heater must be installed where electricity is supplied by Access Energy Cooperative.
